Project on Gender-Based Violence during the Khmer Rouge Regime

Cambodian Defenders Project (CDP) is a non-governmental organization providing free legal aid to marginalized groups. In 2009, CDP established the project on “Gender-Based Violence (GBV) during the Khmer Rouge Regime” to support victims of forced marriage, rape, sexual torture and other forms of GBV.

The project intends to raise awareness on GBV in conflict to increase understanding and empathy through outreach and advocacy activities. In addition, CDP represents victims who participate in the proceedings before the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia which is currently trying the senior leaders of the Khmer Rouge regime. Our program includes psycho-social support for our clients and psycho education on consequences of sexual violence, trauma and healing.

We are currently looking for a **psychologist** with experience in the field of trauma work.

Key Responsibilities:

- provide psychological support during activities with clients
- plan and conduct psycho-education on trauma, healing, psychological consequences of sexual violence
- provide input on mental health issues during outreach activities
- facilitate truth-telling and experience sharing among victims
- administrative tasks and translation

Essential Requirements:

- Cambodian national
- university graduate in psychology
- good understanding of gender issues
- advanced written and spoken English
- proficiency in Microsoft Office applications
- highly motivated, willingness to learn
- ability to work in a team, good communication skills
- work experience in civil society is a plus
- experience in working with survivors of the Khmer Rouge regime and trauma work is a plus
